New Changes to the ADA and Impact on 504 Plans: What Advocates, Parents and School Districts Need to Know!

Effective January 2009, the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) was amended to include among other changes, a broader definition of a person with a disability. These changes to the ADA also impacts Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act which defines the scope of 504 plans in our schools.
