**Transition Planning: What Parents & Advocates Need to Know**

Parents are an integral part of the multi-year process of planning for the transition of their child with a disability from school to post-school activities. Transition regulations begin the year a child turns 12 years of age and becomes a part of the IEP development process for students age 15 and older. This workshop will provide participants, with information about transition regulations and effective practices, including vocational evaluations, transition components of the IEP, developing post secondary goals and working collaboratively with teachers and the CSE committee.
